I have worked at Moscow Orphanage № 4 since April 2009. I teach English in the 7th form (ROOF's EC Group 6).

I like teaching there. All the students are great. Each of them is a character. They all are interesting and unique. I'm very glad that most of the students want to study English and understand why they need it.

Sure, they are kids and that's why sometimes they make noise, start hitting each other. To prevent such situations we made an agreement: they behave themselves, and I come to them and teach interesting lessons.

I try to include a game, which will attract the kids, into each lesson. E.g., we learn the alphabet through a game. My students name letters one by one. There is no strict order who and when will call letters, so, if several students call the letter all together, we start the game from the very beginning. The kids enjoy this game so much, that they are playing it independently at their free time. We learn numerals just in the same way.

In the near future I am planning to attract my colleagues to teaching at the Orphanage. I hope that meeting new people will help my students to broaden their minds and will strengthen their interest in studying English.
